WINEMAKING

Grapes were taken to the winery in 22 kg boxes. After a rigorous selection, stalks were removed and grapes were crushed and transferred to stainless steel vats. The alcoholic fermentation took place at controlled temperature for 7 days.

AGEING

In stainless steel vats.

TASTING

Colour: Bright purple. Nose: Pronounced aroma intensity. The nose shows fresh notes of wild berry fruit and delicate floral hints. Palate: Elegant beginning that leads to a wine with a good backbone of rounded, finely-textured tannins nicely combined with fresh wild berry notes. Medium length and balance on the finish.

Residual Sugar: 1.8 gr/L
